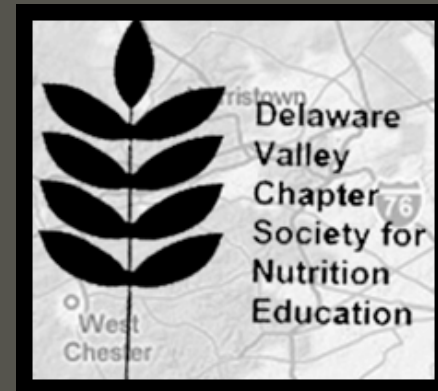
About DVCSNE
