

### **Scholarship of Teaching and Learning Nutrition in Higher Education Award Criteria**

The Scholarship of Teaching and Learning Nutrition in Higher Education Award is presented to recognize outstanding SNEB members for their scholarly contributions to and student engagement in higher education. This award is designed to honor exemplary nutrition faculty who motivate college student learning through innovative and effective teaching methods.

#### **Criteria for Nomination**

1. Current SNEB member
2. Nominated and sponsored by a current SNEB member in any membership category
3. Employed full-time at a college/university with at least 25% effort towards teaching nutrition
4. Completed at least 3 years of teaching at the collegiate level
5. Record of outstanding achievements in teaching nutrition in higher education. These achievements can include:
  - Scholarship evaluating teaching and learning strategies
  - Activities inside and outside of the classroom that indicate service to students
  - Mentoring graduate and undergraduate students
  - Mentoring faculty to improve their teaching effectiveness in the classroom
