



*Society for Nutrition Education & Behavior Mid-Career
Award Criteria*

The mid-career award is presented to recognize an SNEB member in "mid-career" regarding his/her professional accomplishments in the field of nutrition education and for significant contribution to the mission of SNEB.

Criteria for Selection:

An award committee is appointed by the SNEB Board to evaluate nominations using the following five criteria:

- 1) Nominated and sponsored by a current SNEB member in any membership category.
- 2) At least ten but not more than 19 years of professional work in nutrition education
- 3) Current professional membership in SNEB and professional member status for at least 5 years (not necessarily consecutive)
- 4) Professional accomplishments in the field of nutrition education
Recipients must have a record of outstanding achievement in the field of nutrition education and promotion and made acknowledged contributions to the field. This achievement could include breadth and quality of accomplishments (e.g., teaching, advocacy, curriculum and materials development, work with other organizations, media, industry, policy makers, and other collaborators), the success or impact of the nutrition education and promotion, resources, grants or program changes garnered in support of the nutrition education and promotion to assure sustainability and/or growth of a program, intervention, or other type of nutrition education and promotion effort. Accomplishments also considered could be leadership of large nutrition education and promotion programs or collaborations and publication of scholarly materials related to nutrition education and promotion.
- 5) Significant contribution to SNEB, as a volunteer leader or in another capacity that fosters SNEB's mission ((To promote effective nutrition education and healthy behavior through research, policy and practice).
