

USDA USDA FNS Programs and Services 15 Nutrition Assistance Programs Serving 1 in 4 Americans each year \$>80 Billion dollars







Using USDA Foods for Emergency Feeding

State Agencies have the authority to use USDA Foods from nutrition assistance program inventories for congregate feeding:

Child Nutrition Programs
The Emergency Food Assistance Program
Food Distr. Programs on Indian Reservations
Commodity Supplemental Food Program

Administrative waivers/flexibilities requested by States (examples)

Same location for multiple schools
All school and emergency shelter meals at free rate
Missing meal 'components'
WIC substitutions: liquid formula for powdered; shelf stable milk or juice, etc.
SNAP hot food purchases

USDA D-SNAP Authority, Approval and Eligibility Operations approved when an area has received a Presidential Disaster Declaration for Individual Assistance (IA). • States request approval to operate; FNS approves operations for a limited period, typically 7 days. Recipients must reside in the disaster area, have experienced adverse effects due to the disaster, and meet income limits.
